(Stuttering and Fear of Speaking)



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What is the state of stuttering in speech?

Slurred speech is a type of speech disorder that may impair a person's ability to speak fluently

Symptoms of stuttering:

- Repeating the pronunciation of certain words or sound syllables.
- Frequency before uttering words.
- Replace certain words with other words.
- Avoid saying a few words.

Work steps:

Wood was used as a solid base material, randomly carved and colored black to show the feeling of fear, tension and inner, and anxiety.

The Arabic letters were added randomly and scattered to indicate the collision and scattering of letters when speaking, then the remaining sawdust was added to parts of the work to express the imprisoned speech and the inability of the letters to launch.
